- Concerts with live audiences: moratorium from district to expire Nov. 1. Our concerts are planned for Dec., so will have time to decide.
- Tshirts plan to assess end of this week , pending final classroom shuffling

#### From the Treasurers (Kirsten and Brian):

- Brian is doing financial review of records from last year, Kirsten will determine what paperwork is needed and filing information
- Kirsten will continue to do day-day
- Program fees \$7,200, so goal met
- Flowers/veggies \$3,675 in sales, minus cost and portion to Title 1 schools, our net is \$900
- Costs approx \$6000 on instruments and repairs so far this year, plus \$2000 on music
- \$24k in bank currently

### From Fundraising (Karla and Emmy):

- Karla is kindly managing this fundraiser- starting now through Nov 3rd, online only orders
- Paper message to go out to all kids at school about chance to buy
- Will have distribution Mon./Tues. prior to Thanksgiving
- Wreaths and garlands available
- Sales goals \$2,500 will need to sell 250 units
- Emmy training to take over this event next year
